What PalAss can provide:

The Association currently runs a large internet server, capable of serving multiple website projects simultaneously. As part of our charitable aims we will consider hosting external projects that align with our stated aims (see http://www.palass.org/association).

Only use point 12 font in either Times New Roman or Arial. No more than 3 pages of A4. Save as a PDF document.

1) Brief statement on the project and intended use of PalAss hosting:

- Introduction to your project.
- Aims/goals.
- Public/scientific impact.
- Future directions of the project.
- Does the project fit within the PalAss charitable aims? (see http://www.palass.org/association)

2) Reason for PalAss to host the site(s):

- State why PalAss is being approached to host your project.

3) Personal involved in the project:

- List of main contacts, with one person nominated as the primary contact.
- List of technical skills your personnel have with regards the running of the project.

4) Technical Information:

- Current website size (MB or GB).
- Estimated bandwidth (MB or GB) used per month.
- Do you have a domain name, or is one required?
- What coding language does your project have/intend on using?
- Will you require SSH access? If so, please state what this will be used for.
- Will you be uploading any non-standard web-content (i.e. very large videos, downloadable applications, etc.)?
- Will you be requiring the use databases (i.e. MySQL)?
- Will you be requiring the use of additionally installed software on the server (e.g. mailing lists, VPN, etc...)?
- Will you be requiring assistance to migrate an existing project to our servers? If so:
 - State what you envisage this will evolve.
 - State the details of your current server.
- Will you be requiring PalAss to maintain your project once hosted on our servers? If so:
 - o How much time (hours) per week/month/year do you envisage PalAss providing?
 - o What particular project related tasks are you requesting that PalAss undertake?

5) Other:

- Will you be selling or undertaking any financial transactions through the website?



- Is the project primarily based in the United Kingdom, EU, or other? (if other please state)
- Will you be maintaining the copyright/ownership of all/some/none of the uploaded material?
- On what date do you envisage needing to use the PalAss hosting facilities.
